



## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

1. High touch surfaces are cleaned before, during, and after the worship service. Please do your part by washing your hands or using hand sanitizer.
2. Building capacity is limited to **63** people. Please maintain six feet of physical distance between yourself and those not in your household and sit in marked seats.
3. Masks are required for everyone ages 5 and above. Children ages 2-4 may wear a mask at their parent's discretion. The CDC says masks should NOT be worn by children under the age of 2.
4. Parents, please keep your children with you at all times.
5. For the safety of others: If you have sore throat, cough, chills, body aches for unknown reasons, shortness of breath for unknown reasons, loss of smell, loss of taste, fever at or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit OR if you have been around someone with these symptoms within the last 14 days, please do not attend church.
6. For your own safety: If you are in a high risk category (over the age of 65 or having certain underlying medical conditions including but not limited to cancer, kidney disease, COPD, obesity, compromised immune system, and serious heart conditions) please do not attend church.
7. The following screening question will be asked upon arrival: Do you have any reason to believe you or anyone in your household has been exposed to or acquired COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
8. Temperatures will be taken on arrival using a touchless thermometer. Those with a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit and above will not be allowed to enter the building.
